# Annual report



This year marked a shift from operating in emergency mode to systematic work. If in 2022 we stood our ground, in 2023 - we expanded.

Not only did we continue our flagship projects, but we also found resources for new, even more ambitious ones, forged strong partnerships, established priorities, and secured record funding! Our main focus now is on overcoming educational loss and addressing the challenges posed by wartime. I am pleased that, alongside highly practical products like The All-Ukrainian Online School, Can't Wait to Learn or REducation, we have made room for unifying and creative initiatives - the Teachers of the Future festival, the collection of stories "Live to Teach," and our documentary film!

We also engaged in significant reforms and transformational processes. We celebrated 10 years of Osvitoria — a significant milestone, a time for maturing and maximally focused energy, balanced by experience. What a treasure — to meet this moment, gathering as a team in person at the Osvitoria Hub despite everything!

In 2023, it became unmistakably clear: education cannot be put on hold and postponed to better times. Because education itself creates those "better times," meaning — it's directly up to each of us. I am happy to be on this path of change together.

Working in education and contributing to the future of our country in these challenging times is both a great honor and an even greater responsibility. It is this awareness that drives us to exert extra efforts to restore and create opportunities for quality education for children.

In 2023, our team embarked on 18 educational projects. This includes national-level initiatives like the All-Ukrainian Online School and Can't Wait to Learn! We also hosted significant events such as the Global Teacher Prize Ukraine and the "Teachers of the Future" festival. We enhanced our most authoritative online media on education and upbringing, reaching nearly 5 million readers!

With the expansion of our project portfolio, the Osvitoria team also grew — by 50% in 2023 and threefold overall since the full-scale invasion. Our team is Osvitoria's most significant and most valuable asset. Beyond focusing on educational development, we also concentrated on enhancing the operational capacity of the association. We have successfully automated the onboarding process, where each new team member now takes a mini-course led by the NGO's heads and departments on our core working principles.

I want to extend my gratitude to our partners and the Osvitoria's friends. This year, over 500 educators from Ukraine and abroad contributed to our projects. We deepened our cooperation with the government and several influential organizations that share our journey towards the development and rejuvenation of education. As we approach the uncertain year of 2024, we move forward with gratitude for everyone who stood by us in the past year, with faith in the Armed Forces of Ukraine, and with the best team in the entire world!

# OVERCOMING EDUCATIONAL LOSSES

For many years, while systematically working on the development of education, Osvitoria could not ignore the most open and painful wound of today — overcoming educational losses.

This year, in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and with the support of UNICEF Ukraine, we have launched three projects in this direction.





Undoubtedly, we need to respond to educational losses right now. But how do we measure educational losses? Which tools should we choose? How can we help students? Today, these questions concern everyone. To help teachers and students catch up with the school curriculum without stress, together with leading experts, we have created an educational project for teachers. The training will take place in a cascading model: first, the selection and training of trainers; then, offline training of teachers in the regions; as well as online courses available to every educator. This approach has already proven its effectiveness during the New Ukrainian School reform, so we are confident that this format will be beneficial for teachers".

# HOW DO WE HELP THE STATE OVERCOME EDUCATIONAL LOSSES?

#### • We have released the courses

'Catch Up: Overcoming Educational Losses' and 'Discover: About Distance and Blended Learning,' which have already been completed by over 5500 educators.

#### • We have trained 197 trainers

in knowledge catch up and organization of distance and blended learning, who are already training teachers in the regions.

And we are confidently moving towards our KPIs to train over 50,000 teachers!





# TEACHER INSPIRATION



The goal of the **Global Teacher Prize Ukraine** during full-scale war is to tell the stories of teachers as a way to thank them and recognize the importance of their work.

In 2023, we collected over five hundred stories from across Ukraine and for the second time honored teachers during wartime who remain innovators in challenging conditions and embody Ukrainian education during wartime.



#### This year, for the first time:

- We honored teachers from preschool educational institutions.
- Supported by partners, the honored teachers received 3 million and 1 million UAH from FCA for the implementation of their own educational projects.
- An exhibition featuring the stories of wartime teachers was opened in the Kyiv metro.
- External advertising was launched in 18 cities across Ukraine urging people to thank teachers.

"Live to Teach" is a collection of 80 teacher stories about the war, which became a symbolic summary of 2022 - a year of resilience and change. We gathered these stories from the beginning of the full-scale invasion to document educational losses and record the important steps taken by teachers to preserve education.

The heroes of the collection are Ukrainian educators who continue to teach in extreme conditions, often risking the most precious thing they have - their lives. Thanks to these individuals, the educational process in Ukraine continues despite all the challenges of war.



# WE ADVOCATE FOR THE IMPORTANCE OF EDUCATION IN A NEW WAY!

This year, we began filming a documentary together with Kateryna Hornostai, one of the most renowned Ukrainian directors, and 2Brave Productions. It's a story about school and childhood during wartime.

For the second year in a row, Osvitoria in collaboration with War Child and with the support of the Ministry of Education, has been developing the mobile application Can't Wait to Learn. With this app, students in grades 1-4 can study according to Ukrainian educational programs under any conditions and from anywhere in the world.

This is a unique product for Ukraine where educational video lessons are combined with mini-games, all content corresponds to the state program, and the characters of the application were created together with children.

- We developed lessons in Crimean Tatar language and literature, integrated 0 courses in language and literature, basics of health, and technology.
- We modernized materials for lessons in grades 5-6 according to the New Ukrainian School (NUSH) standards.

#### Within 3 months of work, we released 686 lessons, half of which are already on the platform.

# EQUAL ACCESS TO QUALITY EDUCATION

This is our real emergency educational assistance!

We address the individual needs of public schools to facilitate the restoration of the educational process during the full-scale war.

#### Key figures of the first year of operation:

- We received **1510** requests from schools
- We provided assistance to restore and improve the educational process to **60** schools with over **3 000** students
- More than **250** units of computer equipment and other supplies were delivered to **17** regions of Ukraine
- School principals rated the positive impact of the project on the educational process at 9,4 out of 10



# THE FIRST PROFESSION

Osvitoria's oldest and most heartfelt project is the First Profession. Through this project, we teach orphans and deprived children the skills of their first professions, enabling them to independently earn a living and not fear unemployment in the future.

#### We take pride in the following achievements:

- This year, **180** children were enrolled in **25** clubs.
- As a pilot initiative, we introduced a career guidance component, conducting **10** career counseling sessions for graduates.
- **27%** of group graduates went on to pursue vocational • education in the field of their club's specialization.



# **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

For 9 years now, our Scholarship Program has been providing students with outstanding academic, creative, or athletic achievements the opportunity to receive quality secondary education at the Novopecherska School - the most innovative school in Ukraine for free.

> This year, we received 162 applications the highest number in recent years! 9 scholarship recipients began their studies at the Novopecherska School, and a total of 26 students are acquiring knowledge through the program.



# OUR COMMUNICATIONS

This year, our goal was not only to communicate loudly but also systematically-equally about each of Osvitoria's projects.

Our annual media coverage reached over **75 mln** contacts, with 60 million of them being communication support for the Global Teacher Prize Ukraine.

#### Under sirens, threats, Ukraine's children go back to school

Ukrainian children on Friday began their second school year since Russia launched its full-scale invasion, forcing classes online and in underground bomb shelters in several parts of the country. More than 1,300 Ukrainian schools were destroyed over the past 18 months, but the dangers will not stop Ukrainian children from going back to school again.

This year, we continued to receive requests for comments on the state of education in Ukraine from international media outlets such as France 24, Süddeutsche Zeitung, and Le Monde.
